
Our vision in Doregos Private Academy is to bring out the best in every student and for them to reach their potential.

JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL

he Junior Secondary School comprises preparatory classes for the Senior Secondary School. At this level, students are taken thorough academic processes that enhance their learning experience. At the end of the Junior Secondary School education, students are expected to write an external examination, e.g. BECE and over the years our students have always been excelling in the external examinations.



SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL

n innovative curriculum is in place to teach the senior students how to solve problems and discover new ways of thinking. The students are expected to sit for external examinations – WAEC and NECO. Our students are reputed for having exceptional results every year and the records can be made available on request.



THE CURRICULUM

he academic curriculum of the college is divided into parts - the Junior Secondary School and Senior Secondary School in strict compliance with the National Policy on education. The students are prepared for Junior Secondary Certificate (JSCE) by the State Ministry of Education and National Examination Commission (NECO), The Senior Secondary Certificate



Examination (SSCE) by WAEC and NECO, the Cambridge GCE O'Level Examinations, the American SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) and TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign language.

FOREIGN EXAMINATIONS

Cambridge International Examination. We also offer other foreign programmes which include SAT and TOEFL. With these foreign programmes in place, we provide students with rigorous academy support and also offer the best route to an undergraduate degree in the USA, the UK, Canada, Australia, etc. We parade professional educators that are passionate about the success of the students. CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

Il prospective pupils/students must write a qualifying entrance examination before being considered for admission. After the successful performance in the examination, parents will be duly notified and a non-refundable stipulated amount must be paid to secure the child's position at the school. Parents are to note that the school reserves the right to refuse admission to any child/student.

ASSESSMENT

t is important for students to perform to the best of their ability in order to maximize their potentials. Part of our fundamental aim at Doregos Private Academy is to instill confidence in our students to meet the challenges of life and education. Students at Doregos Private Academy are constantly prepared for an effective transition from one class to another via Unified Test and Examination every term. Constant assessments are also typically organized in both individual and group settings and these include practical exercises, research projects, presentations, written essays and so on.



SCHOOL SAFEGURDING AND PASTORAL CARE



he Pastoral and Safeguarding Unit provides an avenue for the students to consult with the Safeguarding Officer (Child Protection Officer) and the Counselor on any issue relating to educational, personal, social, mental and emotional states of the




YORUBA DUNKA

FACILITIES

BOARDING HOUSE

he college offers standard boarding facilities. The boys and the girls hostels are conducive, clean and secure. All rooms are well ventilated with a stand-by generator. Hostel life is pleasant and well monitored. The students follow a daily routine of chores, siesta recreation and prep. They are watched over by firm but caring house masters and house mistresses. The students take their meals in the centrally located dining hall. Hostel rules are to be adhered to strictly as contained in the hostel rules and regulations issued. Students are permitted to leave the school premises in case of emergency or as the case may be but must obtain permission from the Principal or any assigned officer during school hours and any other hour of the day for boarders.



FOOD TECHNOLOGY

he School offers practical Home Economics courses. Female students are prepared for their future roles as mothers. The Home Economics courses are exhaustive making available instructions on the welfare of the family as a whole. Our laboratory provides students with a conducive environment for practical areas of Food and Nutrition.





FINE ART/DESIGN STUDIO

t Doregos Private Academy, we believe that an introduction to creative arts is an important part of the development of a child. Students are encouraged to develop interests in these areas. The Music Laboratory and Fine Art Studio are just places to awaken their creativity.



SCIENCE LABORATORIES

CLINIC

he school has a clinic run by professional doctors nurses. The clinic caters for minor ailments that students develop in school. This is at no cost. Serious cases are however referred hospitals in the neighbourhood while the cost of treatment will be settled by the parents. Students who are newly admitted will be made to undergo medical examinations in the school. It is important that parents provide the school with adequate medical history of their wards.



CHESS ROOM

he game of chess is learnt and taught every week in the school. The students are constantly exposed to competitions with students from other schools. The board game develops reasoning and IQ of students planning for real life issues. The school has a chess room equipped with sets and clocks which the students practice with on a weekly basis.



UNINTERRUPTED POWER SUPPLY

he school places much premium on the well-deserved comfort of the students hence the provision of uninterrupted power supply via the standby generators and the sola powered inverter.
