Every child in this band is received into a homely environment that allows them to learn and relax as they grow. Every child at this level is given individual attention by professional teachers. They are also exposed to appropriate resources, diverse play toys and great classroom ambience for positive learning.

NURSERY

his section admits children from the age of 20 months to 5 years. It is placed under the leadership of an experienced supervisor, assisted by a number of dedicated teachers with Montessori background. As a matter of fact, the staff of this section are motherly, caring and loving.



This section places so much emphasis on safety and comfort. Priority is given to individual contact, to ensure that each child is guided in activities and learning experience appropriate for him/her. No undue emphasis is placed on formal academic work. It is important to note here that creche is not part of the school's nursery education but a day care centre in a formal school environment.



t. Bernadette School at this level promotes the widest possible range of subjects for children from the age of 6 years to 10 years to have a well balanced curricula. Character is developed and maintained in a happy, yet disciplined atmosphere, necessary to provide the high standard of education in manners, speech and moral principles.

This will enable our pupils take their place in the world as responsible

citizens. Pupils, after the completion of their primary six education, are expected to take the National Common Entrance Examination into Federal Government Colleges. The pupils are also expected to take the Primary Six Leaving Certificate Examination though the Lagos State Ministry of Education allocating the pupils to different secondary schools. Admission into other private secondary schools is also encouraged.

THE CURRICULUM

CURRICULUM OF THE NURSERY

ur curriculum is a hybrid blend of British and Nigerian with basic Montessori principles and resources. This section prepares children academically, provides structure and schedule, teaches social interaction, independence and physical activities.





CURRICULUM OF THE PRIMARY

he school curriculum is broad based. It contains not only the subjects recommended by the Ministry of Education but more. The adoption of the curriculum is based on the premise that pupils attending St. Bernadette School are prepared for the National Common Entrance Examination for admission into secondary school.

These subjects include: Mathematics, Quantitative Aptitude, English Language, Verbal Aptitude, Social Studies, Science, Robotics, Yoruba, Religious Knowledge, Moral Instruction, Physical and Health Education, Computer and Music. Others are Home Economics, Literature in English, Phonics, Fine Art, French Language with Movement and Dance.

ADMISSIONS

CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

dmission to St. Bernadette School is open to all children from age 3 months to 10 years, irrespective of tribes, colour and creed. Parent are advised to purchase application forms and prospectus from the school at a specified fee. Entrance assessments are conducted for new intakes into all classes except Creche.

ASSESSMENT

he school believes that pupils respond more positively to the opportunity for their success than the threat of failure thereby making achievement both recognizable and possible for all of them. Pupils have two continuous assessments and an examination respectively. The result is always conveyed to parents.



SCHOOL SAFEGURDING AND PASTORAL CARE

he Pastoral and Safeguarding Unit provides an avenue for the students to consult with the Safeguarding Officer (Child Protection Officer) and the Counselor on any issue relating to educational, personal, social, mental and emotional states of the students.



The personnel in charge are qualified and highly experienced by virtue of the series of trainings they have attended. They also create an atmosphere where child feels comfortable to divulge any perturbing issue(s).

ACADEMIC CALENDAR



There are three terms in a school year and they are as follows:

September to December 1st Term January to March 2nd Term April to July 3rd Term

All school holidays are in accordance with the Lagos State Ministry of Education School Calendar. Public holidays are also observed. School opens from Mondays to Fridays. Nursery section starts from 7:45am to 2:00pm while the Primary section starts from 7:45 to 3:30pm.

The science laboratory is fully equipped and upgraded from time to time to meet the needs of all our pupils.

COMPUTER LABORATORY

There are enough system units to accommodate a full class with each pupil having unhindered access to develop his or her skill. FOOD TECHNOLOGY



he school has a well-equipped Home Economics Laboratory that is aimed at helping pupils develop manipulating skills in the area of food and nutrition practices, needlework and craft work.

CREATIVE ART STUDIO





rt is the ability to observe and imagine things around us in terms of line, colour, texture and form. Through the study of Art, our pupils are encouraged to express themselves irrespective of language or nationality. Children are taught diverse forms of Art which include Drawing, Painting, Weaving and Tie-dye among others. Their artistic skills and creativity adorn our walls and are visible all round our school premises.



MUSIC STUDIO

he school has a fully - equipped music room with variety of instruments. Pupils are introduced to various music forms like Jazz, Folk, Classical, Contemporary, etc. Also, they are trained to sing in the choir, solos, duet and dynamics, and play all sorts of musical instruments.



GAMES ROOM

ducating the whole child is our priority; therefore, our children are exposed to diverse brain tasking games like scrabble, chess, etc. The Games Room is designed to expose our challenging pupils to games. Excellent results over the years have proven that children learn fast this way and acquire knowledge which is not only sufficient for all academic and examination purposes, but also broadens their knowledge.



PLAYGROUND

here is a provision of a comfortable and conducive area for the children to play.

Pupils are exposed to special equipment for climbing on, riding on, swinging on, etc.





BOARDING HOUSE

he boys and girls hostels are conducive, clean and secure. All rooms are well ventilated with a stand-by generator. Hostel life is pleasant, and well monitored. The pupils follow a daily routine of chores, siesta recreation and prep. They are watched over by firm but caring housemasters and house

mistresses. The pupils take their meals in the centrally located dining hall. Hostel rules are to be adhered to strictly as contained in the hostel rules and regulations. Pupils are permitted to leave the school premises in case of emergency or as the case may be but must obtain permission from the Head of school or any assigned officer during school hours and any other hour of the day for boarders.



CLINIC

he school clinic is supervised by a qualified medical doctor and certified nurses respectively. Minor ailment that children develop in the school are attended to at no cost. Serious cases are referred to hospitals in the neighborhood while the cost of treatment will be settled by the parents.

It is important that parents furnish the school with adequate medical history of their wards. In addition, pupils on admission newly will be made to undergo medical examinations in the school clinic.

MINI-STADIUM

he Mini-Stadium is a modern compact playground with artificial grass, well laid race track and pavilions that shelter the pupils. Pupils have unrestricted access to the mini-stadium during their leisure time.



UNINTERRUPTED POWER SUPPLY

he school places much premium on the well-deserved comfort of the pupils hence the provision of uninterrupted electricity supply via the stand-by generators and the sola powered inverter.





UNIFORMED SECURITY AND 24HOURS CCTV COVERAGE

he school is well secured by highly trained security personnel with professional certified mode of operation. We also have CCTV cameras for surveillance in and around the school premises 24/7.

ookshop plays an important role in keeping the pupils interested in books. We provide a wide range of good and quality books to improve the vocabulary, communication and grammar skills of the pupils.

AFTERNOON MEALS

upils are served afternoon meals to provide high-energy food with high nutritional values at a subsidized rate. The meals are provided to help pupils focus on their studies without hunger as a distraction.
